

George Town Streets of Harmony & Historical Enclave Walking Tours

Tour starts from where Penang history starts with 200 years of Multicultural History – **Fort Cornwallis** where the British took possession of the island for the East India Company. Then, we will walk across to the Streets of Harmony where the



guide will give a brief explanation around the area of King Street, the temples, clan associations etc. Then proceed to visit the **Pinang Peranakan Mansion** (Baba Nyonya Museum) and enjoy a tour of the Mansion which takes you back to the time of the Baba & Nyonya, set in the home of one of Penang's historical personality, Kapitan Cina Chung Keng Kwee.



Mariamman Temple (Hindu Temple) and also an area where the money changers, jewelry shops are and arrive at the **Teo Chew Association** which has won the UNESCO Asia-Pacific Heritage Conservation Award in the year 2006.

Then we walk across the Kapitan Keling Mosque, the largest historic mosque in town founded in 1801. The tour will end with a special highlight - experience the fading masterpiece of taking



trishaw of Penang to **Tanjung City Marina** for their dinner at Hainan Town Restaurant.



After the mansion tour, we will walk past Saree shops, accessories, joss sticks and an old mill grinding chilly and spices in Little India. The guide will provide explanation on different meals offered by these stalls including the ever so popular *Roti Canai* and *Teh Tarik*. From Market Street, we will pass by Sri
